

**TO ENSURE CONTINUOUS MEMEBRSHIP AND HENCE INSURANCE COVERAGE, PLEASE SEND THE APPROPRIATE FEE AS OUTLINED BELOW TO THE OWP OFFICE NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 31. DO NOT WAIT FOR AN INVOICE. A SALES RECEIPT WILL BE SENT FOR YOUR CHEQUE.**

### **1, FULL SERVICE CLUB**

**Fee:** \$460 (\$433.96 fee and \$26.04 GST)

A club is considered *FULL SERVICE* if:

- Participates in Provincial Championships, events or leagues or
- Participates in National Championships, events or leagues or
- Participates in events outside of Ontario

### **2, RECREATIONAL CLUBS**

**Fee:** \$135 (\$127.36 fees and \$7.64 GST) for recreational clubs.

A CLUB is considered *RECREATIONAL* if:

- A club with teams that will NOT be attending National, Provincial championships or International tournaments or
- A club with teams not playing in sanctioned competitive leagues and
- The club is primarily for recreational purposes.

**FULL SERVICE and RECREATIONAL clubs are eligible for the following services and programs from the OWP**

- Comprehensive \$5 Million dollar Liability Insurance, and Sports Accident Insurance
- Additional insured certificates at no extra cost.
- A club can register all of its volunteers, active parent participants, chaperones, Board of Directors, etc, as part of the club fee. These volunteers are covered by insurance.
- Each club's Board of directors has a \$2 million dollar of directors and liability insurance coverage extended to them by Water Polo Canada
- Links and coverage of events on the OWP website and bulletins
- The use of the Online database for record keeping and communication to members and alumni
- Voting rights at the OWP AGM as per the Bylaws and Constitution
- Water Polo Canada Membership
- Participation in OWP incentives, initiatives and access to promotional materials
- Access to Travel Permits for Worldwide Liability coverage.
  - ⇒ Full Service clubs will receive FREE travel Permits for out of province or out of country events provided ONLY competitive members are attending.
  - ⇒ Recreational clubs and Full Service clubs that travel with one or more recreational members will be required to pay a \$53.00 administrative fee (\$50 fee plus \$3.00 GST) per trip.

### **3, AFFILIATE TEAM/LEAGUE MEMBERSHIPS**

**Fee:** \$30 (\$28.30 fees and \$1.70 GST)

These are teams, leagues, groups which are competitive, recreational, instructional or other but play/train under the umbrella of a high school, college, university, a parks and recreation department or similar organization. These groups generally do not have a board of directors or are incorporated as a water polo club. It is expected that they have accident and liability insurance through the school board, university, municipality etc. **THESE GROUPS WILL NOT RECEIVE any INSURANCE COVERAGE through the OWP or WPC POLICY**

**If an individual with a competitive, recreational or associate membership with the OWP participates in activities with an OWP affiliate club or other non-affiliated group the OWP/WPC insurance coverage will NOT be in effect.**

These groups may enter teams in non-championship OWP events and tournaments, provided that they have their own insurance coverage and provide proof to the OWP.

Affiliate club(s) also benefit by using OWP trained referees, attend clinics and training sessions for coaches and officials sponsored by OWP and benefit from relationships with the OWP and/or our member clubs. These categories of clubs are eligible for the following services and programs from OWP

- Links and coverage of events on the OWP website and bulletins
- The opportunity to register for OWP coaches, referee clinics, ILWP and other events sponsored by the OWP.
- The OWP can provide mentoring services on technical and tactical components of the Water Polo.
- The use of the Online database for record keeping and communication to members and alumni
- Will provide assistance in scheduling of games and officials.
- Affiliate club members will receive the OWP newsletter 'Inside Water'
- Affiliate club officials will receive the OWP Officials Newsletter.
- Invitation to the OWP AGM as an observer
